

Night work and road closure on Gardeners Road/ Bourke Street, Mascot

As part of upgrading Gardeners Road and Bourke Road/ Street under the New M5 project, ongoing night work will be required to investigate the depth and location of existing utilities and install new conduits in preparation for their eventual relocation. This work is required to be undertaken at night under traffic management for the safety of workers, motorists, pedestrians and cyclists as car volumes are lowest.

Timing and scope of works

Work will be carried out intermittently over ten nights, weather permitting, from **Wednesday 31 January to 28 February 2018**. Work will occur between the hours of **9pm and 5am** each night.

Work will take place on **Gardeners Road and Bourke / Road Street at multiple locations**. A map showing the various locations of the work is provided overleaf.

The work will involve trenching across the full width of Gardeners Road, removing ground material, identifying the services and their depth in the ground, installing new conduits and then reinstating the earth.

Equipment used during the work will include lighting towers, hand tools, vacuum truck, excavator, bucket trucks, generators, traffic management and construction vehicles.

Traffic changes

A complete road closure on Gardeners Road and Bourke Street/ Road will be in place for the duration of each working night. Access to driveways located on Gardeners Road will be maintained for residents and businesses at all times. Residents and businesses will be required to provide their address to traffic control to be permitted through the closure to access their property. A map showing the location of the road closure and alternate detour routes is provided overleaf.

Traffic control, signage, detours and reduced speed limits will be in place to assist local residents and road users to navigate through the changes.

Minimising impact on residents

The work is expected to create moderate noise levels to nearby residents. Every effort will be made to minimise noise and light spill associated with this work by:

- Scheduling noisy work to take place early in the night where possible
- Changing the location of work each night
- Turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- Using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- Directing noise generating equipment and lights away from residential properties where possible.
