

## Weekend road closures – May Street, St Peters

Work is underway to install and upgrade utilities along Campbell Street and surrounding intersections. Work will take place on May Street over two weekends to install new drainage pipes and electrical conduits. Trees clearing will also take place during this time. Traffic changes and road closures are necessary to facilitate this work.

### Timing and work hours

Road closures will be in place on May Street for **two weekends between Friday 7pm and Monday 5am**. There will be **3 night shifts and 2 day shifts** of work associated with each weekend road closure. In the event work cannot be completed over the two weekends, a third weekend of work is required. This work will be conducted over the weekend when traffic volumes are lower for the safety for workers, motorists, cyclists and pedestrians.

### Weekend road closure dates

- **7pm Friday 10 November to 5am Monday 13 November**
- **7pm Friday 17 November to 5am Monday 20 November**
- *7pm Friday 24 November to 5am Monday 27 November as a contingency*

### Impacts of work

Work is scheduled to take place on the **northern side of May Street between Campbell Street and Council Street**. Entry to May Street northbound will be closed to traffic from Unwins Bridge Road, Campbell Street and Bedwin Road. A detour will be in place via Campbell Street. May Street residents and businesses should enter via Princes Highway.

Tree Clearing will take place on the southern side of May Street and Unwins Bridge Road. Please see the map overleaf to better explain the location of this work.

Parking restrictions will be in place on May Street from **7am on Thursday 9 November** and **7am on Thursday 16 November** to allow the work area to be set up and be in place for the duration of the weekends of works.

Traffic control, signage, detours and reduced speed limits will be in place to assist local residents and road users to navigate through the changes.

### Equipment used

Equipment used during the work will include compactor, road saw, dump trucks, concrete truck, chainsaw, hand tools, trucks, light vehicles, lighting towers, mobile cranes and excavators.

### Minimising community impact

The work is expected to create some noise impacts to nearby residents. Every effort will be made to minimise noise and light spill associated with this work by:

- scheduling noisy work to take place early in the night where possible
- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery during night work
- directing noise generating equipment and lights away from residential properties where possible

During the works, pedestrian and cyclist access will be detoured away from the road closure and work zone. Traffic control will be in place to manage traffic impacts.

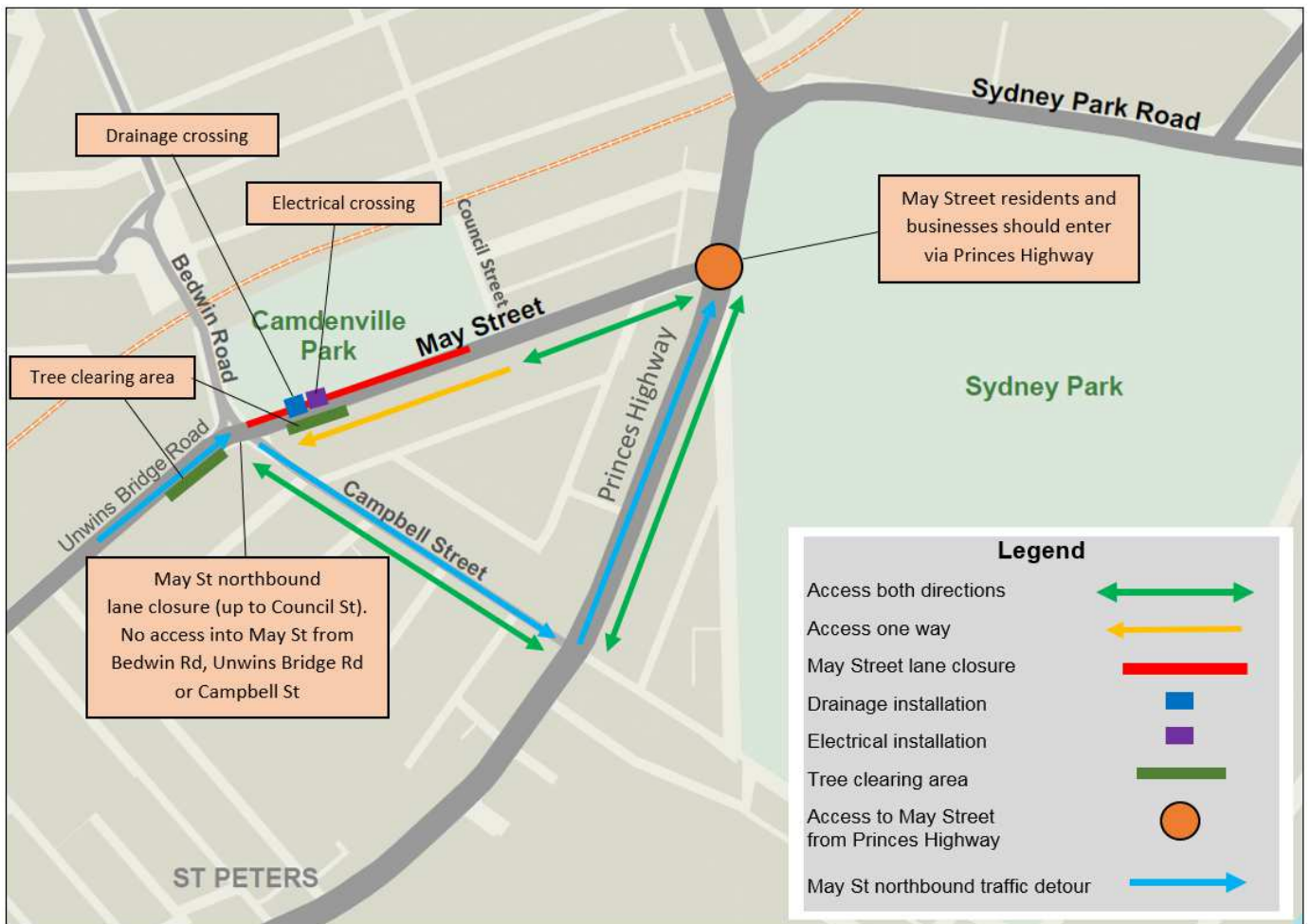
