

Daytime piling work and night work on May Street, St Peters

Day time piling work is underway in Camdenville Park for construction of the new retaining wall adjacent to Bedwin Road. Work is also ongoing to realign the intersection of Campbell Street, May Street, Bedwin Road and Unwins Bridge Road and install and upgrade utility services in this area.

Timing and work hours

- **Camdenville Park piling work** is underway to install 38 steel piles for the construction of the new retaining wall in Camdenville Park along Bedwin Road. This retaining wall is being built in advance of the Bedwin Road widening which will change alignment of the road to straighten the traffic intersection at May Street, Campbell Street and Unwins Bridge Road.
Piling work will take place during standard construction hours from **Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm** and on **Saturday from 8am to 1pm**. There will be no night work associated with this activity. Piling work is expected to be completed by **February 2018**.
- **May Street night work** - on **Wednesday 20 December** from **7pm to 5am**. The concrete barriers currently in place on the southern side of May Street, near to the intersection of Campbell Street, will be relocated to the northern side of May Street during one night of work. Only southbound traffic will be permitted during the night works. This work will be conducted at night when traffic volumes are lower for the safety for workers, motorists, cyclists and pedestrians.

Impacts of work

- **Camdenville Park** - Residents may experience minimal vibration in areas directly surrounding the southern side of Camdenville Park. This is a common technique used in urban areas. If you feel small vibrations in your property due to construction activity there is no cause for concern. Every effort will be made to minimise construction impacts and vibration monitoring will be carried out during piling works. A piling rig is being used to install the piles.
- **May Street night work**
 - Only southbound traffic permitted on May Street at the intersection of Unwins Bridge Road and Bedwin Road. No access into May Street from Unwins Bridge Road, Bedwin Road or Campbell Street. Please use Princes Highway to access May Street during this night work. Traffic control, signage and reduced speed limits will be in place to assist local residents and road users to navigate through the changes.
 - Parking restrictions will be in place on the northern side of May Street near the Campbell Street intersection from **7am on Tuesday 19 December till approximately April 2018**.

Equipment used

Equipment used during the work will include a piling rig, mobile crane, truck, light vehicles, lighting tower, and hand tools.

The work is expected to create some noise impacts to nearby residents. Every effort will be made to minimise noise and light spill associated with this work by:

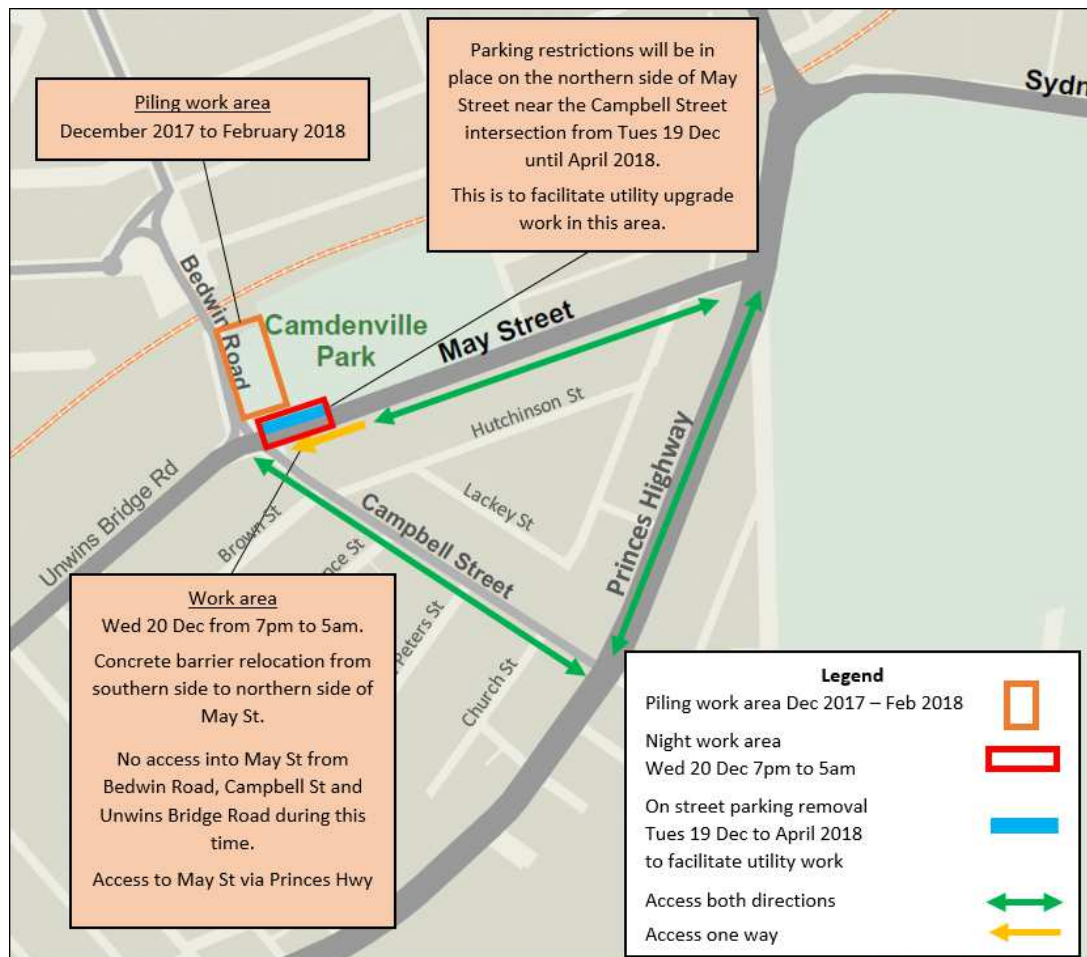
- scheduling noisy work to take place early in the night where possible

- using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery during night work
- directing noise generating equipment and lights away from residential properties where possible

Traffic control will be in place to manage road users through the changes.
