

Out of hours work & traffic impacts at Sydney Park Roundabout, Alexandria

Night work will be undertaken on Sydney Park Road to install concrete barriers and conduct some utility investigation works at the roundabout. This work is being carried out outside of standard construction hours under traffic management when traffic volumes are lower for the safety of workers, motorists, pedestrians and cyclists and to avoid congestion during peak traffic times.

Scope of work

The crew will be conducting two activities during this work:

- Installing concrete barriers along the westbound slip lane on Sydney Park Road as part of site establishment. The New M5 site is being extended approximately 60 metres down Sydney Park Road in order to commence tie in road works. Note, Sydney Park Road is not being widened
- Conducting service investigations at the roundabout in order to complete installation of the water main

Equipment used during the work will include cranes, trucks, lighting towers, hand tools, Hiab truck, vacuum trucks, scanning wands and construction vehicles.

Date and time of work

Concrete barrier installation	Friday 2 February	9pm to 5am (only expected to take 3 hours. Low noise impact)	Temporary closure of one westbound traffic lane
Service investigation	Saturday 3 February & Sunday 4 February	8am and 6pm	Roundabout operating under stop/ slow arrangement. One lane of traffic permitted through roundabout at a time. Queuing and delays expected. Westbound traffic closed on Huntley Street between Burrows Road and the roundabout
Service investigation	Saturday 10 February & Sunday 11 February	8am and 6pm	Same as above
Service investigation	Saturday 17 February & Sunday 18 February	8am and 6pm	Same as above

Traffic changes

Changed traffic conditions will be in place during the work, including a stop/ slow arrangement at the roundabout whilst we undertake service investigations (similar to previous weekends at the roundabout). **We encourage local residents and businesses to avoid using the roundabout during this work if possible.**

Minimising noise

Both activities are not expected to generate high noise levels. Every effort will be made to minimise noise and light spill associated with this work by:

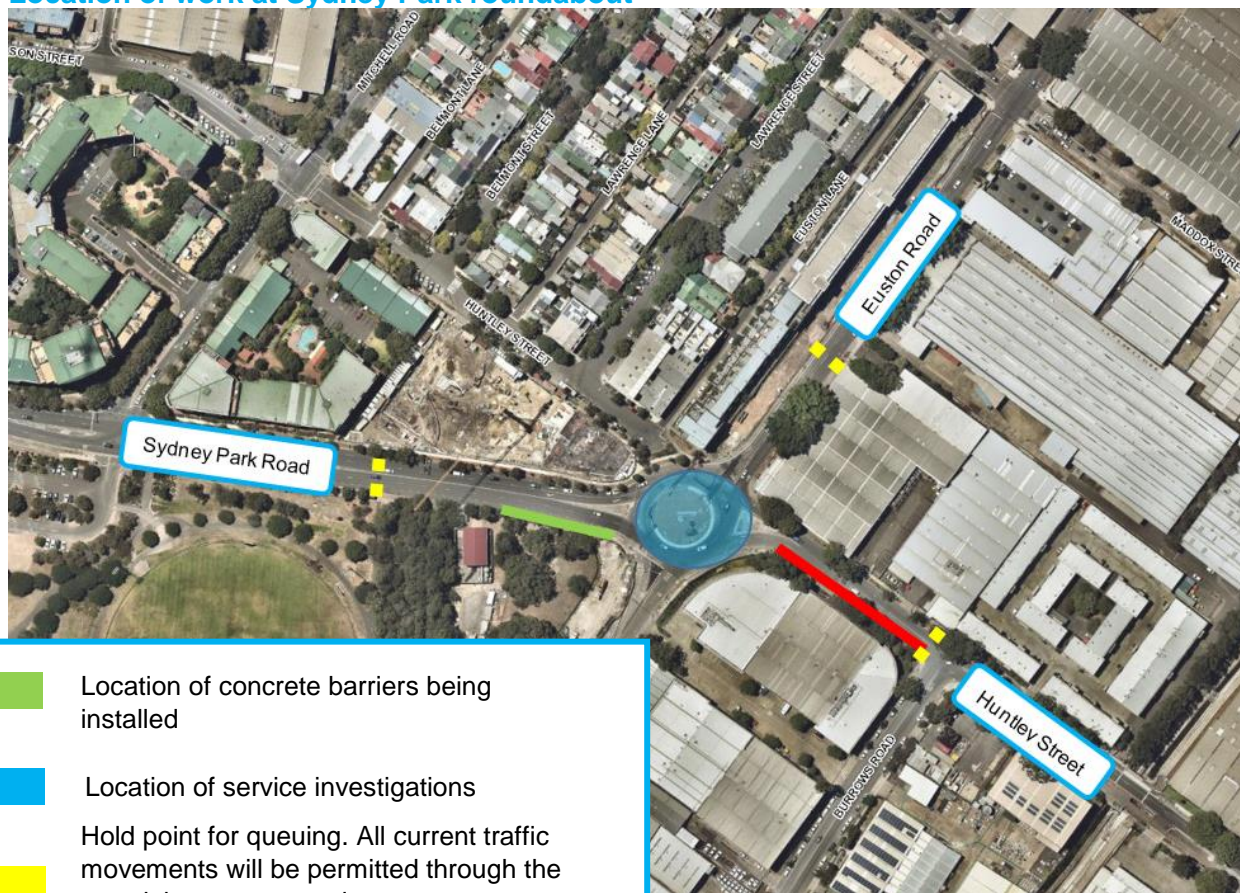
- Turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- Using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- Erecting noise blankets around the work area where possible
- Directing noise generating equipment and lights away from residential properties where possible
