

Night work and traffic changes on May Street and Campbell Street (west) St Peters

Night work will be carried out to install and relocate concrete barriers and fencing along May Street to allow for the upgrade of utility services in this area.

The concrete barriers on the western side of May Street will be relocated to extend the work site towards the roadway. A temporary footpath will be created in the current road shoulder behind the concrete barriers and temporary fencing will be erected in front of the kerb. This set up will allow for the removal of the current footpath which is necessary to complete utility upgrade work, pavement widening and drainage installation.

Concrete barriers on the eastern side of May Street will be installed to facilitate tree stump removal and utility investigation work. Following investigation work, the current footpath will be removed for drainage and utility installation and upgrade work. A new pavement and footpath will be built after the utilities have been installed in mid-2018.

Timing and work hours

Night work will take place on **Tuesday 30 January** from **7pm to 5am** to install and relocate concrete barriers on both sides of May Street near the intersection of Campbell Street. Concrete barriers will be placed in front of the work areas for the safety of pedestrians, motorists and construction workers while work is being carried out. If concrete barrier installation is unable to be completed in one night shift, an additional night of work will take place on **Wednesday 31 January** from **7pm to 5am** to complete the activity.

Traffic changes

- Two-way traffic will be maintained on May Street during night work with stop / slow traffic in place
- Traffic control will also be in place on Unwins Bridge Road, Bedwin Road and Campbell Street around the intersection. Traffic in both directions will be maintained.

This work will be conducted at night when traffic volumes are lower for the safety for workers, motorists, cyclists and pedestrians. Traffic control, signage and reduced speed limits will be in place to assist local residents and road users to navigate through the changes. Please allow for delays while this night work is being carried out.

Impacts of work

Parking restrictions will be put in place on both sides of May Street near the Campbell Street intersection from **7am Monday 29 January** and remain in place while this utility work and pavement construction is being completed. The current parking lanes on May Street near the intersection of Campbell Street will become traffic lanes after this work has been completed. **On street parking will no longer be available in the work area shown on the map overleaf.** We apologise for any inconvenience this will cause.

Pedestrian and cyclist footpath access will be maintained along May Street during the upgrade work. At times, during work hours, pedestrians and cyclists may be detoured under direction from traffic control personnel across May Street away from the work areas.

Access to properties will be maintained at all times.

Equipment used during night work will include a mobile crane, truck, light vehicles, lighting tower, and hand tools.

The work is expected to create some noise impacts to nearby residents. Every effort will be made to minimise noise and light spill associated with this work by:

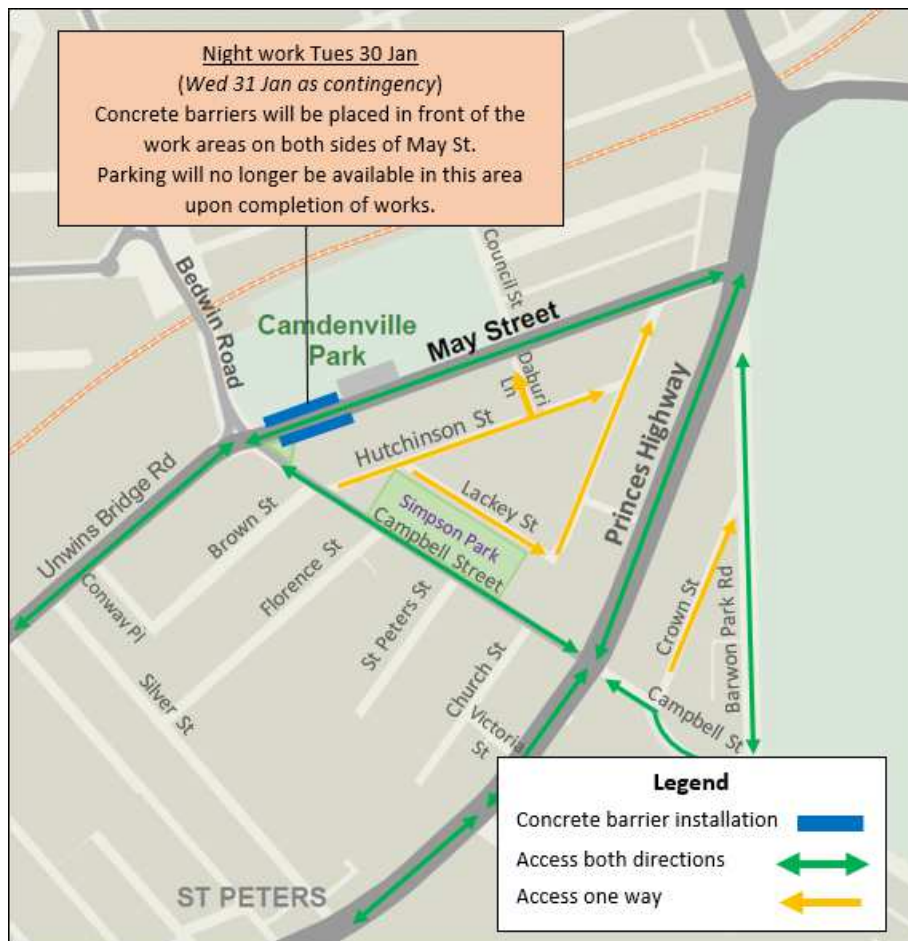
- scheduling noisy work to take place early in the night where possible
