



Upcoming work south of the M5 East

Preparation work will begin south of the M5 East at Beverly Hills for road widening of the M5 East and incorporation of the new off ramps for the New M5.

What we're doing

Beginning the week of 19 March, tree removal will take place in the area south west of the Kindilan Underpass between the M5 East and Wolli Creek bordering the Tallawalla Street Reserve. This work will take place within the boundary of the New M5 Project.

Work will be undertaken Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm (weather permitting) and Saturdays from 8am to 1pm. As work progresses and we have firm dates for the remaining work we will provide further information.

The area will be replanted as shown in the Urban Design Landscape plan which can be found at www.westconnex.com.au/newm5draftUDLP.

How this affects you

Some of this work will be noisy.

We will use equipment that will include chain saws, hand tools, light vehicles, tree stump remover, excavator with grabs, shears and ripper, wood chipper & mulching machine and large trucks.

Signage will be in place to assist pedestrians and cyclists through any changed access conditions.
