



Night time deliveries to the Kingsgrove Tunnel Compound

As work progresses on the Kingsgrove site you would have seen a number of changes to our footprint in the area.

What we're doing

Delivery and Removal of Equipment

In the coming weeks we will be receiving a number of oversized deliveries to our Kingsgrove Tunnel compound (entrance on Garema Circuit Kingsgrove).

Due to the oversized nature of the deliveries, the trucks are restricted to specific time frames for deliveries.

How this affects you

The first of the overnight deliveries will be on Saturday 16 and Tuesday 19 June between 2am - 6am; however there will be ongoing overnight deliveries over the coming weeks.

During these deliveries where possible we will minimise the impact to the community by receiving the delivery and not unloading the equipment until the next day during regular construction hours.

Some of this work may be noisy. Noise modelling has been conducted for work undertaken outside of standard construction hours.

For the works outside of standard construction hours, we may use: lighting towers; cranes and construction vehicles.
