Update: Reinstatement of roads, footpaths and driveways – Kingsgrove, Earlwood, Bexley & Clemton Park

We recently installed underground power cabling from an existing substation in Campsie to the New M5 construction compound at the corner of Bexley Road and the M5 East Motorway. The new cables were commissioned in November 2016 and are now connected to the Ausgrid electricity network.

The final stage of this work involves permanently reinstating the cable route to its original condition. The reinstatement work will be carried out progressively and will include:

- removing the temporary asphalt surface in affected areas along the cable route
- installing new sections of road, footpaths, kerbsides and driveways

Equipment used during the work will include excavators, bobcats, concrete-cutting saws, hand tools, concrete trucks, asphaltting machinery and light vehicles.

Timing and work hours

Work is currently underway to reinstate the affected areas along Alfred Street, Clemton Park as well as Poole Street, Lundy and Rosemeath Avenues, Kingsgrove and will be completed by late-April, subject to weather.

The remainder of the reinstatement work is expected to take up to **three months** to complete, weather permitting. Working hours are from **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm on Saturdays**. No work will be carried out on Sundays or public holidays. Due to high traffic volumes, work near the intersection of Nicholas Avenue, Bexley and Canterbury roads will need to be undertaken at night. Deliveries of construction vehicles may be undertaken outside of standard construction hours due to day time road restrictions.

Temporary traffic changes

Changed traffic conditions, including reduced speed limits, lane closures and pedestrian detours will be in place during this work. Traffic will always be maintained in both directions. Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist road users, pedestrians and cyclists through the changed conditions.

Construction Impacts

Driveway and footpath restrictions may be required as part of this work. The project team will contact any directly impacted residents and businesses to discuss their access requirements and make any necessary arrangements.

You may experience some noise during this work. We will implement reasonable and feasible measures to minimise impacts. Noise monitoring will be conducted for any work that takes place outside of standard hours. Any dust generating activities will be watered down to minimise dust. Every effort will be made to reduce the impact to residents and businesses while work takes place.
