

Cycleway Diversion During Construction of the M4 Widening Project

All routes are signposted, please ensure you follow the signs and take care. Your patience and cooperation is appreciated while these important works are underway.

The Cambridge Street, Allen Street, Good Street is a short term diversion to accommodate piling interface until late 2016.

Cycleway diversion in this section via the shared user path next to Duck Creek/John Ian Wing Parade/Hill Road/Pondage Link/Edwin Flack Drive/Sarah Durack Drive/paths in Bicentennial Park and alongside canal /Pomeroy Street/Queen Street/Princess Avenue and Concord Road.

Due to the closure of Fox Street underpass, pedestrians can use the Pitt Street overpass which links the shared path to Railway Street, Granville.

Due to the closure of Fox Street underpass, cyclists can use Auburn Street footbridge which links to the cycleway via Fox Street and Robert Street. The Pitt Street overpass is not suitable for cyclists. The diversion is to accommodate civil works to facilitate the M4 Widening Project.

Long term M4 cycle diversion route. Implementation period approximately 24 months. Cycleway diversion in this section via the existing shared user path on the southern side of the M4 Motorway.
