## Underground power cable installation, Campsie

Work is underway on WestConnex which involves widening and extending the M4 and M5 and joining them to create a free-flowing motorway network.

As part of the project, the New M5 will duplicate the existing M5 corridor, doubling vehicle capacity and easing congestion between St Peters and Beverly Hills. It will include twin tunnels, an upgrade of the King Georges Road Interchange and a new interchange at St Peters. Work will soon commence to install underground power cabling from an existing substation in Campsie to the proposed New M5 construction compound at the corner of Bexley Road and the M5 East Motorway. This work will be undertaken by electrical contractors, Electrical Energy. A map showing the work in your area is provided overleaf.

Due to high daytime traffic volumes on Canterbury Road, work along this road between the intersections of Bexley Road and Nicholas Avenue will need to be done at night.

Excavation work will be carried out along **Canterbury Road between Bexley Road and Nicholas Avenue, Campsie** for eight nights intermittently beginning on Thursday 22 September 2016, weather permitting. Some minor finishing work will be undertaken during daytime hours.

Work hours will be Monday to Saturday from **6.00 pm to 7.00 am**, with noisier work completed early in the night. No work will be carried out on weekends or public holidays.

The day before work commences near your property, a representative from Electrical Energy will visit you to explain the works. This representative will be carrying photographic identification.

The work will involve:

- underground utilities investigations
- trimming and removing vegetation
- excavating and trenching the road, footpath or verge using excavators with rock breakers, trucks, water carts and other equipment
- installing plastic ducts and pulling in and connecting power cables
- ongoing traffic and pedestrian management to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers.

Traffic and pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the works. Access to residential driveways may be limited for up to one day as work moves along the route. You will be consulted before any access changes occur.


